Speech

- Content
 - Did you teach us something?
 - Did you make goos use of your prop/drawing/etc?
 - Did we understand what you were talking about?
 - Were you interesting and appropriate for this audience?
- Organization
 - → Structure
 - Introduction: attention-getter, preview and what you will teach us
 - Body: three (or more) main points or parts of the topic
 - Conclusion: review
 - Transitions
 - Did the speech flow nicely?
 - Did you use natural-sounding segues?
- Delivery
 - Voice: volume, pitch, articulation, pronunciation
 - ▶ Tempo: speed, pauses, use of filler words (don't)
 - Body Language: eye contact, gesturing, posture, friendliness
